

Job Opening for National and International Candidates - Professor (Tenure-Track) Social Work or Social Sciences, Economics, and/or Administrative Sciences Professional

The School of Social Work at the Faculty of Social Sciences at the Pontifical Catholic University of Chile, is opening a work position and receiving applications for the position of a tenure-track professor (44 working hours). Specifically, the School is looking for professionals with expertise and specialization in social, economic and/or administrative areas, who may contribute to consolidating our School's academic project.

The candidates must have a PhD in Social Work or a related discipline within the Social Sciences.

Candidates must have experience in areas related to organizational and community development, as well as areas relating to administrative or social planning, social organizations, local development, disability and labor, social policy, social innovation and sustainability, non-profit organizations, social innovation and sustainability, citizen and community participation, social organization, collective action, and diversity, among others.

Candidates must demonstrate deep dedication and commitment to research, teaching and reflection in their area of work. Work experience will be highly valued. Participation in national and international networks related to professional and academic development will also be highly regarded.

The candidate must have a consolidated line of research, reflected in peer-reviewed publications (in indexed journals) and awarded funds during the last five years.

Fluency in Spanish and English is required. The job position requires dedication and ability to develop undergraduate and graduate courses, and contribute to the development of high quality social science research.

This offer includes the possibility of becoming part of a high-quality educational institution with a long-standing tradition in Chile. If chosen, the candidate will also be receiving a competitive salary.
